■ GPA (Grade Point Average) System

◇ Each grade carries a grade point value (GP). Rikkyo University calculates its grading system as follows:

$$GPA = \frac{\text{the number of grade points multiplied by the number of credits for the course}}{\text{total credits (including F)}}$$

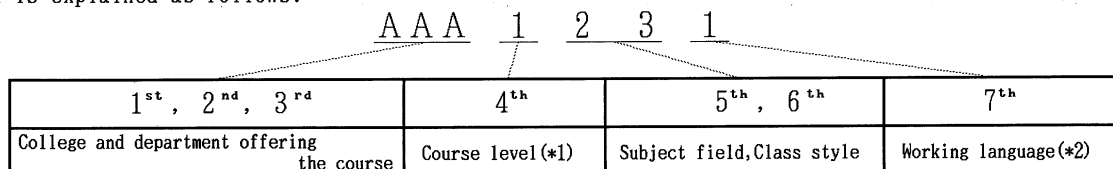
◇ Grade evaluation criteria and GP
