Reception Hall

The Reception Hall is ideal for ceremonies and parties



The Reception Hall can accommodate 48 people in sit-down and up to 80 people in buffet style.

Hours : 9:00 ~ 22:00

(people not staying at the Hall can use it until 20:30.)

Meeting rooms

The Hall offers services for those hosting meetings



The Hall has two meeting rooms and offers services for those hosting meetings, such as equipment rentals (screens, projectors, laptops) and photocopying.

Hours : 9:00 ~ 22:00

(Anyone not staying at the Hall can use the rooms until 17:00.)

Lounge

The lounge can be used for getting rest and meeting place



The television set, refrigerator, microwave ovens and photocopying machine (for a fee) are accessible in the shared lounge.

Hours : 7:00 ~ 23:00

The Hall offers overnight accommodation for up to 48 guests.

(Washing machines and drying
machines can be used until
22:00.)
