# EXPLORING SOCIAL INNOVATION



## PARTICIPATION COSTS

### \$3,300 VIA program fee includes:

- Hotel accommodations (10 nights)
- Transportation for airport pick-up, drop-off, and program activities
- Site visits, guests speakers, workshops, and other activities
- Breakfasts, arrival lunch, and farewell dinner
- 24-hour on-site staff support

### VIA program fee does not include:

- International airfare (~\$1,800)
- Travel insurance (~\$25)
- Most lunches & dinners (~\$300)
- Optional activities (~\$200)
- Personal shopping (~\$100)
- Emergency, medical, and travel disruption costs

### Cost Summary (USD)

Total estimated cost to participate:

- \$3,300 VIA Program Fee (Aug 2024)
- \$2,425+ Additional Expenses
- **\$5,725+ Total Expected Cost**

## WHO IS A GOOD FIT FOR ESI?

We welcome participants from diverse backgrounds and a range of English levels who want to exchange ideas with global peers and explore pathways to social impact leadership!

### Basic Eligibility Requirements:

- Student or starting professional from or connected to Asia (no nationality restrictions)
- At least 18 by program start date
- Able to travel to and enter the US
- Able to meet health or vaccination requirements for US entry or re-entry to home country
