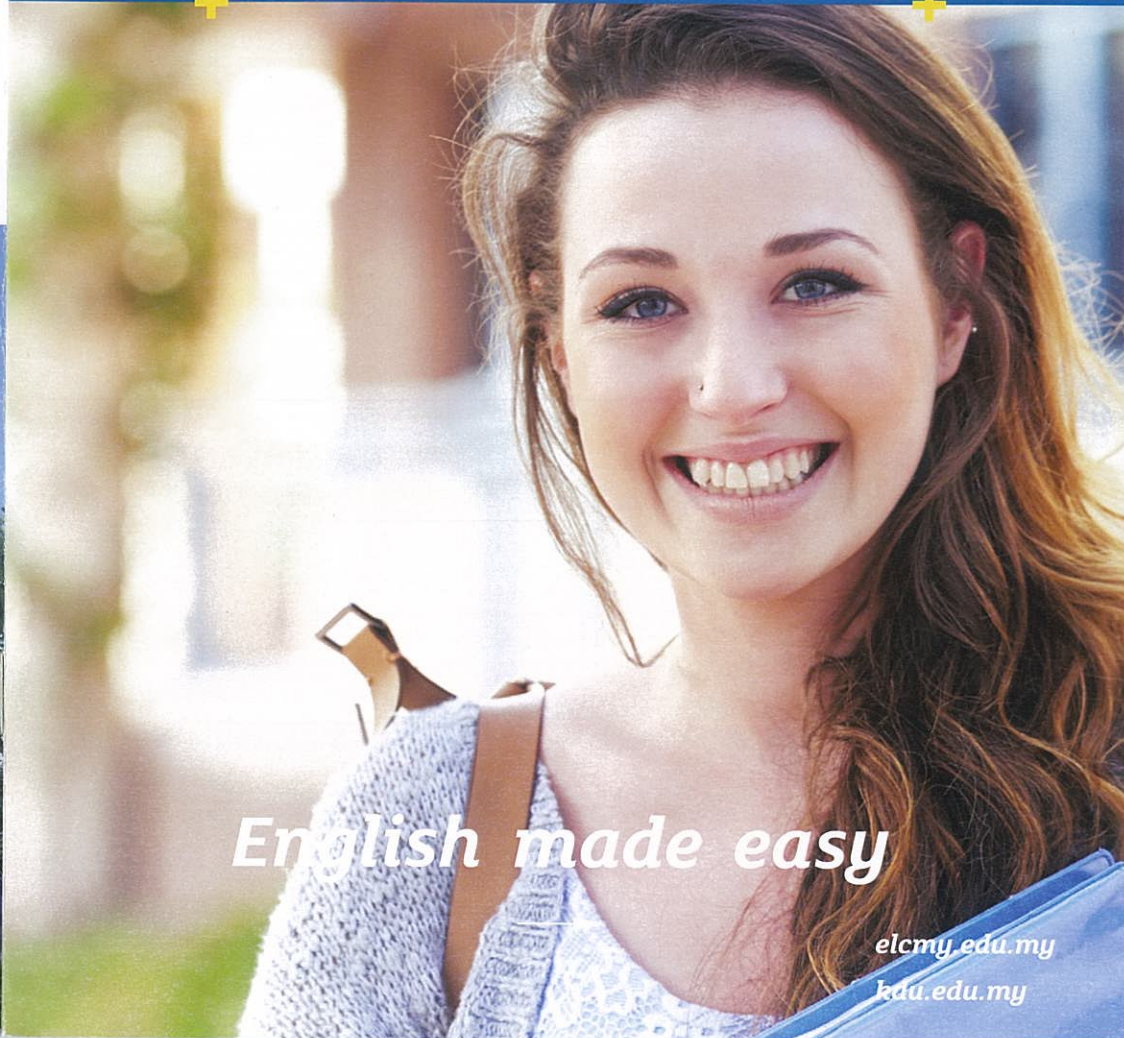

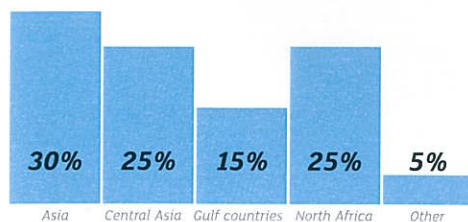

Timetables

What is the test format and how long will it take?

Listening 4 Sections 40 Items < 30 Minutes >	Speaking Oral interview with an examiner, 3 parts to the test < 11 to 14 minutes >
Academic Reading 3 Sections 40 Items < 60 Minutes >	Academic Writing 2 Tasks 150 and 250 words < 60 minutes >

The total test time is 2 hours and 45 minutes. The Listening, Reading, and Writing tests are done in one sitting. The Speaking test may be done on the same day or up to seven days before or after the other tests.

Where to take the test?

You can register for the test in ELC Malaysia. Our IELTS exam co-ordinator will help you to register for the test.

When there are 20 or more students registered for the test on the same date, we will conduct the test on ELC premises. If there are less than 20 students sitting for the test on the same day, then it will be held at the IDP Test Centre.

How much is the IELTS exam fees?

The fees may change due to fluctuation of Ringgit Malaysia (RM) to the UK £. As at October 1st 2017, the test exam fee is RM850.00.

How do you enrol in the exam?

What is IELTS?

IELTS is the International English Language Testing System. IELTS is used to test English proficiency across the globe. With more than 3 million tests conducted globally in 2016, IELTS is the world's most popular English testing system.

Which organisations accept IELTS?

An IELTS certificate is recognised as evidence of proficiency in English by more than 10,000 education and training providers worldwide. Universities in Malaysia and Australia require an IELTS score as the courses are taught in English.

Why are there two versions of the test?

IELTS has two versions – Academic and General Training.

The IELTS Academic test is suitable for entry to study at a tertiary level in an English-speaking country. The General Training test is for those who are going to English-speaking countries for secondary education, work experience or training programs, or migration.

All candidates take the same Listening and Speaking tests but different Reading and Writing tests.

What does ELC Malaysia cover in the IELTS course?

ELC focuses on Academic IELTS. As the format for Academic and General Training are slightly different, if you plan to register for the General IELTS exam, please inform the Director of Studies who will assist you in your preparation.
