Please make sure to let us know promptly in the following cases. XIf the International Office cannot reach you in case of emergency, it can cause disadvantages of various procedures!!

 Change of your Address or phone number in Japan (You MUST notify Academic Affairs Office as well)

- When your leave Japan temporarily for vacation etc.

(Submission of "Notification of Leaving Japan")

Residence Card

You must carry your Residence Card all the time once it is issued! That is required by Japanese Immigration Regulation.

You must present it promptly upon request by an immigration officer or police officer.

If you are not carrying your card with you, the penalty can be a fine of up to 200,000 yen and if you refuse to present it, you may be punished with imprisonment for not more than one year or a fine not exceeding 200,000 yen.

★Notification of a change in an item on the residence card

1 Address :

If you change your place of residence, you need turn in both "Notification of Moving-out" and "Notification of Moving-in" to the city/ward office of your new/previous residence. within 14 days of moving to the new residence.

- (Moving-out) The city/ward office of your previous residence
- (Moving-in) The city/ward office of your <u>new</u> residence
- (2) Other than the address
 - The Regional Immigration Office

Students who graduated from educational institution in Japan and have been staying in Japan with a "Student" visa before the enrollment of Rikkyo

You must submit 【NOTIFICATION OF THE ACCEPTING ORGANIZATION】 to the Immigration Bureau within 14 days of a change in any of the following items mentioned blow:

-when you have left an accepting organization he/she belongs to (for graduation/leaving school/expulsion)

-when you transfer into another organization

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF PERIOD OF STAY

When the expiration date of your duration of stay is approaching, you need to submit an application for the extension of your stay to the Immigration Bureau. You may submit the extension application up to 3 months prior to the expiration date. Before you apply to the Immigration Bureau, you need to submit necessary documents to the International Office to get "Application for extension of period of stay(for organization)" International Office cannot issue "Application for extension of period of stay" on the day you apply for it, so that you should give yourself extra time to get them ready.

You need to go to the Immigration Bureau for the application in person. After you receive a notification from them, you can pick a new residence card. Please make sure you keep the deadline for pickup.

When you have to submit a copy of your new residence card to International Office within a week of the acquisition.

[IMPORTANT : Immigration Bureau strictly inspect ones who take few credits] "College Student" status is given to those staying in Japan for the purpose of study. Your attitude of tacking your study and research is an important element which substantially affect your study abroad life <u>and the Immigration Bureau strictly inspect ones who take few credits</u>. If extending your period of stay is not granted, that will end up disrupting your study abroad life in Japan. <u>You ought to</u> <u>concentrate on study and research at Rikkyo!</u>

APPRICATION FOR PART-TIME WORK PERMIT

If you wish to work part-time in Japan, you have to first obtain "Permission to engage in activity other than that permitted under the status of residence previously granted" from the Immigration Bureau.

Application Destination: The Immigration Bureau

Required Documents: "Application for permission to engage in activity other than that permitted under the status of residence previously granted" form, residence card, passport

XThe application form is available at International Office.

[IMPORTANT: Number of hours you can work] **Working more hours than permitted is against the law**

- Up to 28 hours/week when classes are in session;
- Up to 8 hours/day during the university's official vacation or recess

THE RE-ENTRY PERMIT SYSTEM

Foreign nationals in possession of a valid passport and residence card who will be reentering Japan within 1 year of their departure to continue their activities in Japan will not be required to apply for a re-entry permit. (This is called a "Special Re-entry Permit.")

When you leave Japan, be sure to present your residence card and tick the column indicating your intention of departure by the Special Re-entry Permit System on an ED card for Special Re-entry Permit.

If you will leave Japan for one year or more due to leave of absence, etc. , you need to obtain a re-entry permit from the Immigration Bureau beforehand.

NOTIFICATIONS OF LEAVING JAPAN

When you leave Japan temporarily for your home country or vacation, etc., you need to submit "Notification of leaving Japan" to International Office to notify the period of leaving Japan and your contact information while leaving Japan.



Learning Support

INTERNATIONAL STUNDENT TUTORING SERVICE

In case your academic supervisor deemed necessary, international students who enroll in degree programs may receive guidance in the following kinds of writing in a foreign language during the predetermined period in the same academic year of the submission.

- Master's thesis or equivalent
- Doctoral thesis

However, this support is only available when writing in a language other than your native language. If you wish to use this service, please consult with the International Office in advance.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE AND WITHDRAWAL

If you are forced to take a leave of absence or withdraw from your studies for health or other reasons (including military service), you must consult with the International Office in advance. There are some important things that need to be confirmed.

XThere will be some procedures of your status of residence and things to confirm about your part-time work and Organization Guarantee Program.

XYou must not remain in Japan while you take a leave of absence. In addition, you cannot do any part-time work.

SPECIAL EXEMPTION FROM ENROLLMENT FEE DUE TO OBLIGATORY MILITARY SERVICE

If you take a leave of absence due to obligatory military service, <u>special exemption from enrollment fee may</u> <u>apply for up to 4 consecutive semesters</u>. After you review your study/research plan and the schedule of joining the military, please consult with International Office in advance. You need to submit a notice of leave of absence and a proof regarding the military service for the exemption from enrollment fee.

ORGANIZATION GUARANTEE PROGRAM

If you have no one to be the guarantor needed for signing an apartment rental agreement, Rikkyo University can act as your guarantor organization but only under certain conditions. <u>Please consult the International Office before contacting a real estate broker.</u>

Health Insurance

National Health Insurance Plan

It is a obligation to join the National Health Insurance who stays in Japan more than 3 months. 70% of general medical costs will be covered by this insurance and the remaining 30% must be covered individually. National health insurance card is issued after the enrollment. Application Destination: National Health Insurance Division of City/Ward Office in your district of residence Required Documents: Residence Card, Passport, Student ID, etc.

RIKKYO STUDENT MUTUAL-AID HEALTH INSURANCE UNION

Rikkyo students are automatically joining the Rikkyo Student Mutual-Aid Health Insurance Plan. Part of the medical costs incurred are covered. Handling Office : Division of Student Affairs Student Welfare

Scholarships for Privately-Financed Students



Scholarships

There are scholarships only for international students and scholarships that are in common with Japanese students. The offices dealing with these are different so be careful not to miss out on any opportunities.

■Scholarships in common with Japanese students → Student Affairs Division (Ex. Rikkyo University Graduate School Scholarship)

■Scholarships for international students → International Office

Scholarships for privately-financed international students include "Internal Scholarships" offered by Rikkyo University and "External Scholarships" provided by the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) or private scholarship foundations. And furthermore, scholarships for international students can be divided 2 types. One is the scholarship that require a recommendation by Rikkyo University. The other one doesn't need University Recommendation and international students can apply individually.

There are scholarships that require a recommendation by Rikkyo University among scholarships for international students that International Office is handling. If you wish to apply for scholarships which require a recommendation by university, you have to complete the "Scholarship Initial Registration" every year.

Rikkyo University offers tuition reductions for privately financed international students with "College Student" resident status, facing financial difficulties in pursuing university education. Applications will be screened by the selection committee.

• Reduction Rate The tuition fee reduction rate for the AY2020 is 20%.

• Tuition Reduction Method

Successful applicants will receive a tuition fee payment slip of the 2nd semester installment for the academic year 2020 with the amount calculated by subtracting the tuition fee reduction.

You must pay the full amount of the first installment of the tuition fee regardless of the results of the Tuition Fee Reduction System application.
